THE MONTH OF NOVEMBER

Each month of the year is dedicated to a particular devotion with our Catholic Faith. November is the Month of the Holy Souls. We are encouraged to pray for those who have died, our family and friends, which is natural enough. However, we also pray for those who may have no one to pray for them. In this way, we are joined to others in the Christian family and reminded that we are a wide community united in our belief in Jesus and His Resurrection. Pope Saint John XXIII wrote that "the devotion to the memory of the dead is one of the most beautiful expressions of the Catholic spirit."

On All Souls' Day, a plenary indulgence is granted to those who devoutly visit a church or an oratory and recite an Our Father and the Creed.

A plenary indulgence, applicable to the Holy Souls, is granted each and every day from November 1st to November 8th, to those who devoutly visit a cemetery and there pray, if only mentally, for the those who have died.

The usual conditions to acquire a plenary indulgence are:

- 1. detachment from sin; which is a true sorrow for, and repudiation of, all one's sin, mortal and venial;
- 2. reception of Holy Communion on the day the indulgence is sought;
- 3. prayer for the intention of the Holy Father on the day the indulgence is sought (one Our Father and one Hail Mary suffice, or any other suitable prayer);
- 4. sacramental confession within a week of completion of the prescribed work.

Eternal rest grant unto them, O Lord, and let perpetual light shine upon them. May they rest in peace. Amen.
